Thank you for purchasing your puppy from us.

We guarantee the puppy to be in good health at time of sale. The puppy will be up to date with shots (vets certificate will be included) and worming at the time of pick-up. Important to continue vaccinations. Please do not expose your puppy to other dogs that are not vaccinated until he/she has completed the entire vaccination schedule (around 16 to 20 weeks). Do not take your puppy to a pet store, dog park or neighborhood walk until he or she is vet checked and cleared to do so.

You will need to have the puppy examined by a Licensed Vet within 72 hours of receiving your puppy. If for some reason the puppy deems to be unhealthy or unfit for sale, the puppy may be returned for full refund-provided the puppy has not been injured or neglected. The veterinarian must provide a written statement deeming the puppy "unhealthy" for purchase.

This guarantee does not cover any health issues caused by neglect or injury from the puppy buyer. This does not include minor illnesses and health issues such as colds, allergies, internal or external parasites or umbilical hernias.

We do not assume any responsibility for any medical expenses incurred after the sale. It is the buyer's responsibility to properly care for the puppy and keep it free from harm. Please remember that your puppy must be treated with great care and protected from danger. The early days are very stressful for your new puppy.

The puppy being sold as a top quality pet only. Not guaranteed (no AKC breeding rights) fertility or ability to place in shows. We only breed our dogs to be a great companion.

We give a one year guarantee from the birth date of the puppy against any life threatening congenital defects of the puppy. If this does occur, the puppy will be returned to us (breeder) and the buyer will receive another puppy when one is available. Vet papers are required to show evidence of this.

We recommend not feeding your puppy grain free dog food. See Taurine Deficiency in Golden Retrievers. Golden's have been reported having DCM and congestive heart failure. Feeding your puppy a premium dog food is imperative to their development and adult health.

We are passionate about our puppies. If for any reason, you the buyer, are unable to keep the puppy, you agree to contact Birk's Place and not place the puppy in another home. This is for the life of the Golden. We will always welcome your Golden back. We definitely do not want our puppies to end up in a shelter.

Our Golden's are fed Hill's Science Diet dog food. I have fed this to our dogs for the last 13 years and not had a problem. They are given Bravecto for fleas and ticks and Interceptor Plus for worms and parasites. We do not expose our dogs to other dogs outside of Birk's Place. We also do not use weed killer or fertilizer on our lawn since dogs will lick their paws and be exposed to hazardous chemicals.
